UPCOMING GAMES



Wednesday, Mar. 16, 2016 at Detroit Pistons (7:30 p.m.)

TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks visit The Motor City for the first time this season in the third-of-four contests between the clubs ... The teams will meet once more in Detroit on 3/26 ... The series is split 1-1, with the first two games being played at Philips Arena ... Detroit was a 106-94 victor on 10/27 and Atlanta responded with 107-100 win on 12/23 ... Jeff Teague is averaging 20.5 points, 6.5 assists, 4.0 rebounds and 2.0 steals against the Pistons this season ... Andre Drummond is averaging 21.5 points, 15.5 rebounds, 2.5 assists, 2.5 blocks and 1.0 steals against the Hawks this year ... The Pistons took the last meeting in Detroit on 3/31/15 (105-95), while Atlanta's last road win in the series came on 1/9/15 (106-103) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 174-164 and are 83-74 on the road.



Thursday, Mar. 17, 2016 vs. Denver Nuggets (8:00 p.m.)

TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta welcomes Denver for the only time this season in the second-of-two meetings between the teams ... The Hawks posted a 119-105 road win in the first matchup (1/25) ... Paul Millsap recorded 22 points, nine rebounds, three assists, two steals and one block for the Hawks ... Nikola Jokic had a double-double (15 points/10 rebounds), while adding three assists, two steals and one block for the Nuggets ... Atlanta has taken three straight at Philips Arena against Denver ... The Nuggets' most recent win in the series was a 115-102 home triumph on 3/11/15, while the last win at Philips Arena came on 3/16/11 ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 44-38 (32-7 home mark).



Saturday, Mar. 19, 2016 vs. Houston Rockets (7:30 p.m.)

TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks host the Rockets for the only time this year in the second-of-two games between the clubs ... The Hawks lead the series 1-0, after a 121-115 road win on 12/29 ... Al Horford recorded a double-double (30 points/ 14 rebounds), while finishing the evening with two assists, one steal and one block for Atlanta ... Dwight Howard posted a double-double (30 points/16 rebounds), adding three assists, one steal and one block for Houston ... The Hawks have won four consecutive games against Houston, including two straight at Philips Arena ... The Rockets' last win in the series was a 113-84 home decision on 11/27/13, with the last road win coming on 11/2/12 (113-84) ... Houston leads the all-time series 74-73, with Atlanta holding a 51-22 advantage at home.

* The Hawks have partnered with the Atlanta Track Club to host the second annual Atlanta Hawks Fast Break 5K presented by Kaiser Permanente at Philips Arena on 4/9. Pre-race online registration is open until 11:59 p.m. on 4/6, and includes a commemorative t-shirt, a race photo and headband. The first 1500 registrants will receive a ticket to a Hawks home game. NEWS & NOTES

* In the victory vs. Indiana (3/13), Atlanta had eight different players hit at least one 3FG (a franchise record). It was the sixth game this season and 12th time in team history that the Hawks have accomplished the feat. The Hawks finished the contest shooting 15-30 (.500) from beyond the arc.

* The Hawks came back from double-digit deficits in back-to-back victories, at the L.A. Clippers (3/5) and at Utah (3/8). The last time Atlanta posted consecutive double-figure comeback wins was 3/17-3/18/14 (at Charlotte and vs. Toronto), while the last time it was done on the road was 11/21-11/24/07 (at Miami and Minnesota).

* Paul Millsap recorded 18 points (7-14 FGs, 2-4 3FGs, 2-2 FTs), nine rebounds, four assists, three steals and three blocks in the win vs. Indiana (3/13). Millsap is the only player in the NBA to record at least that stat line this season without any turnovers.

* Al Horford (currently 8067) scored his 8000th career point in the win at Utah (3/8), while Kris Humphries put in career point No. 5000 (currently 5006) in the victory vs. Indiana (3/13).

* Jeff Teague played in his 500th career game (currently 503) at Utah (3/8) and scored his 6000th career point (currently 6010) vs. Memphis (3/12).

* On 3/1, Atlanta assigned Lamar Patterson to Canton and on 3/6 assigned Edy Tavares to Austin of the NBA Development League. Tavares has played in 19 D-League games this season (15 with Austin, two with Canton and two with Bakersfield), with averages of 9.4 points, 8.7 rebounds and 2.9 blocks (.663 FG%, .726 FT%). Patterson has seen action in 12 D-League contests (seven with Austin and five with Canton) averaging 16.1 points, 5.3 assists, 4.5 rebounds and 1.0 steals (.429 FG%, .754 FT%).

* On 3/19 the Hawks will host "Swipe Right 2.0" as the club battles the Houston Rockets at 7:30 p.m. After last season's initial "Swipe Right Night," the Hawks have upped the entertainment factor by working with Tinder to add complimentary glam stations, multiple hosts, a retail component and more unique places for fans to meet in person. THIS WEEK IN HAWKS HISTORY

January 16, 1972 – Pete Maravich scores 50 points in Atlanta's 124-116 home win over Philadelphia. It is tied for the ninth-highest scoring game in Hawks history. Exactly one year later, Maravich put his name in the record books again by dishing out 18 assists in Atlanta's 130-129 home win over Detroit in overtime. It is tied for the fifth-highest assist total in club history.
