Monday, Mar. 21, 2016 vs. Washington Wizards (8:00 p.m.)

TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM/105.3 FM

Atlanta welcomes Washington for the final time this season in the second-of-four contests between the teams ... The clubs will meet again in the nation's capital on 3/23 and 4/13 ... The Hawks won the first matchup, 114-99, at Philips Arena on 11/7 ... Kent Bazemore had 25 points, four rebounds, three assists and two steals for the Hawks ... Otto Porter scored 23 points and John Wall posted a double-double (19 points/11 assists), while adding two rebounds, two steals and one block for the Wizards ... Atlanta has taken three straight home contests in the series ... The Wizards' most recent regular season victory against the Hawks came on 4/12/15 (108-99) at the Verizon Center, while the last win at Philips Arena came on 2/19/14 (114-97) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 149-138 and are 95-43 at home.



Wednesday, Mar. 23, 2016 at Washington Wizards (7:00 p.m.)

TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks travel to Washington for the first time this season in the third-of-four matchups between the clubs ... The teams will meet once more on 4/13 at the Verizon Center ... The Hawks took the first matchup, 114-99, at Philips Arena on 11/7 ... Otto Porter scored 23 points and John Wall posted a double-double (19 points/11 assists), while adding two rebounds, two steals and one block for the Wizards ... The Wizards' most recent regular season victory against the Hawks came on 4/12/15 (108-99) at the Verizon Center ... The last time the Hawks defeated the Wizards in Washington during the regular season was on 11/25/14 (106-102) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 149-138, with Washington holding a 90-47 advantage at home.



Friday, Mar. 25, 2016 vs. Milwaukee Bucks (8:00 p.m.)

The Hawks host the Bucks for the last time this year in the third-and-final game between the clubs ... Milwaukee leads the series 2-0, after a 108-101 (OT) home victory on 1/15 and a 117-109 (2OT) win at Philips Arena on 2/20 ... Paul Millsap is averaging 25.0 points, 10.5 rebounds, 6.0 assists, 3.0 blocks and 1.5 steals against the Bucks this season ... Giannis Antetokounmpo is averaging 23.5 points, 14.0 rebounds, 2.5 blocks and 1.5 assists against the Hawks this year ... The Hawks' most recent victory against the Bucks came on 3/30/15 (101-88) at Philips Arena ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 106-102 (67-37 home mark).



Saturday, Mar. 26, 2016 at Detroit Pistons (7:30 p.m.)

TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta visits Detroit for the last time this season in the fourth-and-final contest between the teams ... The Hawks lead the series 2-1 ... The Pistons won the first meeting, 106-94, on 10/27 in Atlanta, and the Hawks responded with 107-100 victory on 12/23 at Philips Arena and a 118-114 win on 3/16 in Detroit ... Jeff Teague is averaging 21.0 points, 7.3 assists, 3.3 rebounds and 1.7 steals against Detroit this season ... Andre Drummond is averaging 20.3 points, 16.3 rebounds, 2.0 blocks and 1.7 assists against Atlanta this year ... The last time the Pistons defeated the Hawks in Detroit was on 3/31/15 (105-95) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 175-164 and are 84-74 on the road.

* The Hawks have partnered with the Atlanta Track Club to host the second annual Atlanta Hawks Fast Break 5K presented by Kaiser Permanente at Philips Arena on 4/9. Pre-race online registration is open until 11:59 p.m. on 4/6, and includes a commemorative t-shirt, a race photo and headband. The first 1500 registrants will receive a ticket to a Hawks home game. On race day, the 5K is scheduled to begin at 8 a.m. and runs until the course closes at 9:20 a.m. Visit www.hawks.com for more details.

NEWS & NOTES

* Atlanta is currently on a five game winning streak and has taken six straight games at Philips Arena. The Hawks have won eight times in the last nine games and 10 of the last 12 to move to a season-best 12 games over .500.

* In the victory at Detroit (3/16), Atlanta had eight different players hit at least one 3FG (a franchise record). It was the seventh game this season and 13th time in team history that the Hawks have accomplished the feat.

* After home wins over Denver (3/17) and Houston (3/19), Atlanta has now won six consecutive games against Western Conference opponents.

* On 3/16 at Detroit, the Hawks' starting frontcourt all recorded double-doubles: Al Horford (21 points/11 rebounds), Kent Bazemore (first of his career with 15 points/10 rebounds) and Paul Millsap (13 points/10 rebounds). The last time Atlanta had three players each a double-double in the same game was vs. Brooklyn on 1/28/15 (Horford, Millsap and Jeff Teague), while the last time all three starting frontcourt members turned the trick was 2/29/12 vs. Golden State (Marvin Williams, Josh Smith, Zaza Pachulia).

* In the victory against Denver (3/17), the Hawks had eight players score in double-figures. It was the fourth time this season that the Hawks have had eight different players score 10-or-more points in the same game (4-0 record).

* Tim Hardaway Jr. made his first start of the season vs. Denver (3/17), finishing with 21 points (6-11 FGs, 2-4 3FGs, 7-8 FTs), a career-high tying seven rebounds, four assists and one steal, while becoming the first player to score at least 20 points in his initial starting assignment with the Hawks since Paul Millsap tallied 20 at Dallas on 10/30/13. Hardaway Jr. then tallied 20 points (7-11 FGs, 5-7 3FGs, 1-1 FTs) vs. Houston (3/19), becoming the first Hawk to have back-to-back 20 point nights with zero turnovers since Joe Johnson (12/22-12/26/10).

* Tim Hardaway Jr. recorded Atlanta's first four-point play of the season vs. Houston (3/19), the 44th four-pointer in franchise history.

* Paul Millsap recorded a double-double in each of the three games last week. He ranks t22nd in the NBA with 25 double-doubles on the season.

March 27, 1958 – The St. Louis Hawks defeat Detroit, 120-96, in the Western Division Finals to take the series 4-1 and advance to the NBA Finals. The Hawks would go on to defeat Boston 4-2 to claim the NBA title.
