### ALL-TIME REGULAR SEASON/POSTSEASON

Cleveland swept the season series against Atlanta 3-0 (2-0 at home, 1-0 on the road) ... The Cavaliers were victorious 109-97 on 11/21 at home, 110-108 (OT) on 4/1 at Philips Arena and 109-94 on 4/11 at Quicken Loans Arena ... The Hawks most recent victory against the Cavs was on 3/6/15 (106-97) at Philips Arena, and the last time Atlanta won in Cleveland was on 12/17/14 (127-98) ... Five Hawks averaged over 10.0 points per game against Cleveland this year, including Jeff Teague (20.7), Paul Millsap (17.3), Kent Bazemore (15.0), Al Horford (14.7) and Kyle Korver (10.3) ... LeBron James scored at a 27.3 points per game clip against Atlanta this season ... The Hawks lead the all-time regular season series 117-99, including a 70-36 home mark (47-63 on the road) ... The 2016 NBA Playoffs marks the third time (second year in a row) Atlanta and Cleveland have met in the postseason ... Cleveland was victorious in the 2015 Eastern Conference Finals (4-0) and the 2009 Eastern Conference Semifinals (4-0) ... The Cavaliers are the top seed in the Eastern Conference and champions of the Central Division, while the Hawks are seeded fourth.

### NEWS & NOTES

\* Atlanta has now reached the Eastern Conference Semifinals in two consecutive seasons (Conference Finals last year) for the first time since 2009-10 and 2010-11. Since 2008-09, the Hawks have played in the Conference Semifinals five times (including this year).

\* The Hawks held a 2-0 lead in the first round of the 2016 NBA Playoffs vs. Boston, eventually winning the series in six games (4-2). Since moving to Atlanta for the 1968-69 season, the Hawks have taken a 2-0 playoff series lead on 10 occasions, winning all 10 series'.

\* In the Game 5 victory vs. Boston (4/26), Atlanta made 14 three-pointers which ranks as the second-highest total in franchise playoff history. The Hawks have hit double-digit triples on 24 occasions all-time in postseason play, including 17 times since the 2014 Playoffs.

\* Atlanta recorded 13 steals in Game 5 vs. Boston (4/26), tying the club's highest single-game postseason total since 1984-85. The Hawks also had 13 thefts on 5/8/99 against Detroit, 4/29/96 against Indiana and 5/2/86 against the Celtics.

\* In Game 5 vs. Boston (4/26), the Hawks set a franchise record for third quarter scoring with 42 points. Atlanta shot .615 FG% (16-26), .455 3FG% (5-11) and 1.000 FT% (5-5) in the period.

\* Last week, four players moved up the Hawks' all-time playoff leaderboard in several categories (Atlanta-era): Al Horford moved into second in points (899) and second in blocks (92); Jeff Teague is now second in games played (58) and fifth in 3FGM (48); Paul Millsap is tied for sixth in blocked shots (43) and ninth in FTM (122); Kyle Korver is tied for 10<sup>th</sup> in blocks (24).

\* In the 110-83 victory vs. Boston on (4/26), Kent Bazemore made a playoff career-high four 3FGs, and Mike Scott set or tied postseason career-highs points and FGM, finishing the night with 17 points (7-9 FGs, 2-3 3FGs, 1-1 FTs), five rebounds and one steal.

\* The Hawks are 65-16 in the postseason since 1950-51 (the season FGAs began being kept) when holding opponents under .400 FG%, including seven straight wins when doing so (all four wins of the Boston series).

\* Paul Millsap received the Bob Pettit Award as Louisiana's Professional Player of the Year for 2016, as selected by the Louisiana Association of Basketball Coaches (LABC). It is the sixth straight year and eighth time overall that he has won the honor.
