### UPCOMING GAMES



**Monday, Oct. 10, 2016 vs. Cleveland Cavaliers (7:30 p.m.)**

**TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

Atlanta welcomes the Cavaliers to Philips Arena for the only preseason meeting with Cleveland ... The teams will meet four times during the 2016-17 regular season – in Cleveland on 11/8 and 4/7, and at Philips Arena on 3/3 and 4/9 ... The Cavaliers swept the 2015-16 series 3-0 ... In the Eastern Conference Semifinals of the 2016 Playoffs, Atlanta fell to Cleveland 4-0 ... The Hawks' most recent regular season victory was a 106-97 home triumph on 3/6/15 ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 117-99 and are 70-36 at home.



**Thursday, Oct. 13, 2016 vs. Detroit Pistons (7:30 p.m.)**

**TV: FOX Sports Southeast ... Radio: No local broadcast**

The Hawks host Detroit for the only preseason contest with the Pistons ... The clubs will meet three times during the 2016-17 regular season – in Atlanta on 12/2 and 12/30, and at Detroit on 1/18 ... The Hawks won the 2015-16 series 3-1, with their most recent victory coming on 3/26/16 (112-95) in Detroit ... The last time Atlanta defeated the Pistons at Philips Arena was on 12/23/15 (107-100) ... Detroit's most recent win against the Hawks came in Atlanta on 10/27/15 (106-94) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 176-164 (77-79 at home).



**Sunday, Oct. 16, 2016 at Orlando Magic (6:00 p.m.)**

**TV: No local broadcast ... Radio: No local broadcast**

The Hawks travel to Orlando for the only preseason meeting with the Magic ... The teams will meet four times during the 2016-17 regular season – in Atlanta on 12/13 and 2/4, and in Orlando on 1/4 and 2/25 ... The teams split the 2015-16 series 2-2, with the Hawks winning the first two contests and the Magic victorious in the second two games ... The Hawks most recent triumph against the Magic came on 1/18/16 (98-81) in Atlanta, and their last road victory was on 12/20/15 (103-100) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 54-50, with Orlando holding 33-20 advantage at home.

### COMMUNITY NEWS

\* The Hawks will host the first-ever UNITY Game versus the Cleveland Cavaliers. During the preseason contest tonight (10/10), players from both teams will explain what UNITY in their communities mean to them. The game will also feature a halftime address from the National Center for Civil and Human Rights CEO Derreck Kayongo and a check presentation from the Atlanta Hawks Foundation.

\* In conjunction with Jr. NBA Week, the Hawks will host a Coaches Clinic presented by Kaiser Permanente on 10/12. Held at Philips Arena, more than 200 local coaches, athletic directors and community program administrators will hear from a lineup of speakers including Hawks assistant coach Taylor Jenkins along with Hawks alumni Tony Delk, Drew Barry and Roshown McLeod. Attendees will also receive Hawks giveaways, tickets to a preseason game and refreshments.

\* Atlanta Hawks staff along with partners from 92.9 The Game and FOX Sports Southeast kicked off Unity Weekend with a day of service on 10/7. Staff members who volunteered at MedShare ([www.medshare.org](http://www.medshare.org)) helped prepare 426 boxes containing 3,433 pounds of quality, unused medical supplies that otherwise would have been put in local landfills. Supplies will be sent to Haiti to assist in the aftermath of Hurricane Matthew. Other volunteer sites included the Atlanta Community Food Bank, CHRIS 180, Covenant House, Fountain of Hope and United Methodist Children's Home. All organizations received a charitable contribution from the Atlanta Hawks Foundation and tickets to tonight's (10/10) Atlanta Hawks Unity Game versus the Cleveland Cavaliers.

### NEWS & NOTES

\* Tonight's Unity Game against Cleveland will present a sneak preview of the *Breaking Barriers: Sports for Change* exhibition. The exhibition, which made its debut during this summer's ESPY Awards and Sports Humanitarian of the Year Awards in Los Angeles chronicles the stories of how athletes are using the common language of sports to open doors, challenge biases and ensure fair treatment for all. The initial section of the piece will be unveiled at the game, and the full exhibit, spanning 800 square feet and decades of historical events, will live in the arena's Philips Experience footprint for the next 30 days.

\* Atlanta Hawks Basketball Club Chief Marketing Officer Melissa Proctor was named to the Leaders Under 40 list by Leaders and Aspire Academy on 10/4 in London. The annual award, which honored its second group of recipients at the Natural History Museum, celebrates the best talent under the age of 40 years of age in the business of sport around the world.

\* 2016 first round draft picks Taurean Prince and DeAndre' Bembry made their Atlanta debut in the 10/6 preseason game at Memphis. In the 104-83 victory, Prince recorded four points, five rebounds, three steals and two assists, and Bembry posted 12 points, two assists, one rebound and one steal. In two preseason games Prince is averaging 8.5 ppg, 4.0 rpg, 3.0 spg and 1.0 app, while Bembry is recording 9.5 ppg, 2.0 rpg and 1.0 rpg.

\* In his first game as a Hawk, Dwight Howard posted six points and seven rebounds in 17 minutes of action, in the 104-83 victory at Memphis.

\* The Hawks currently have four international players on the roster, including representatives from Cape Verde (Walter Tavares, the first NBA player from the country), Germany (Dennis Schröder), Switzerland (Thabo Sefolosha) and Brazil (Tiago Splitter). Additionally, third-year Assistant Coach Neven Spahija is a native of Croatia.
