### UPCOMING GAMES



**Thursday, Oct. 27, 2016 vs. Washington Wizards (7:30 p.m.)**

**TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

Atlanta hosts the Wizards in the regular season opener for both teams ... The two clubs will meet three more times, at Washington on 11/4 and 3/22, and at Philips Arena on 1/27 ... The teams split the 2015-16 season series 2-2, with each club winning once at home and once on the road ... The Wizards took the final matchup, at Philips Arena, on 4/13/16 (109-98) ... Atlanta's most recent victory in the series was 122-101 road triumph on 3/23/16 (122-101), while the last home win occurred on 11/7/15 (114-99) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 150-140 (95-44 at home).



**Saturday, Oct. 29, 2016 at Philadelphia 76ers (12:30 p.m.)**

**TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

The Hawks travel to Philadelphia for the first-of-four games between the teams ... The clubs will meet again in Atlanta on 11/12 and 1/21, and in Philadelphia on 3/29 ... The Hawks swept the 2015-16 series 3-0, including a 124-86 road win (2/3/16) in the final matchup ... Atlanta has taken two straight in Philadelphia, with the 76ers last home win coming on 3/7/15 (92-84) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 168-160, with the 76ers holding a 91-54 advantage at home.



**Monday, Oct. 31, 2016 vs. Sacramento Kings (7:30 p.m.)**

**TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

The Hawks welcome the Kings in the first of two contests between the clubs ... The teams will meet once more in Sacramento on 2/10 ... The clubs split the 2015-16 series 1-1, with each team holding home court ... Sacramento took the last meeting, a 91-88 decision on 1/21/16 ... The Hawks have won nine consecutive games against the Kings at Philips Arena, with Sacramento's last victory in Atlanta occurring on 3/3/06 (102-93) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 157-153 (87-29 at home).

### COMMUNITY NEWS

\* The Hawks will unveil the *Breaking Barriers: Sports for Change* exhibit for the public on 10/27, when Atlanta opens the 2016-17 regular season against the Washington Wizards. The 800 square foot traveling exhibit, presented by the National Center for Civil and Human Rights and ESPN, explores the history of civil and human rights in sports through stories of athletes. It features narratives of overcoming barriers because of race, disabilities, gender or sexual orientation from past and present greats including Muhammad Ali, Martina Navratilova, Terry Fox, Jackie Robinson, Billie Jean King and Jesse Owens. The exhibit will be available to fans in Philips Experience through 11/12.

\* The Hawks, King of Pops and Parkmobile offered the city of Atlanta two special deals on 10/21. Free parking via the Parkmobile app was available to all, while a newly created Hawks-inspired ice pop was unveiled. The pineapple-lime flavored "Hawksickle" was officially introduced to the city at King of Pops' Bar and Good Grub at Ponce City Market.

### NEWS & NOTES

\* The Hawks' final preseason leaders were: Dwight Howard (14.6 ppg, 10.0 rpg and 1.8 bpg), Dennis Schröder (5.4 apg and 24.5 mpg), Taurean Prince (1.6 spg), Kyle Korver (.586 FG%) and Thabo Sefolosha (.778 3FG%), while Korver, Kris Humphries, Mike Scott, Mike Muscala and Kent Bazemore were all perfect from the free throw line.

\* Thabo Sefolosha ranked first in the league in 3FG% during the preseason; Kyle Korver was tied for first in FT%, t25<sup>th</sup> in FG% (.586) and t37<sup>th</sup> in 3FG% (.500); Dwight Howard ranked fifth in rpg, ninth in bpg and t32<sup>nd</sup> in ppg; Paul Millsap ranked t12<sup>th</sup> in assists (5.3) and t18<sup>th</sup> in rebounds (7.3); Dennis Schröder was 11<sup>th</sup> in apg; Edy Tavares was t16<sup>th</sup> in bpg (1.3), t27<sup>th</sup> in rpg (6.8) and 32<sup>nd</sup> in FG% (.577), Mike Muscala was 38<sup>th</sup> in FG% (.563); and Taurean Prince was t29<sup>th</sup> in spg.

\* Four Hawks averaged at least 10.0 points per game during the preseason: Dwight Howard (14.6), Paul Millsap (12.0), Dennis Schröder (10.4) and Kyle Korver (10.2).

\* Dwight Howard, with 14.6 points and 10.0 rebounds, was one of five NBA players to average a double-double and appear in at least five preseason games (Andre Drummond, Jusuf Nurkic, Hassan Whiteside and James Harden).

\* Rookies Taurean Prince and DeAndre' Bembry both appeared in all seven preseason contests. Prince averaged 7.0 points, 3.6 rebounds and 1.6 steals in 17.0 minutes (.463 FG%, .889 FT%), while Bembry recorded 5.1 points, 1.4 rebounds and 1.1 assists in 16.2 minutes (.424 FG%).

\* Atlanta waived four players last week: Josh Magette (10/22), Will Bynum (10/21), Jarrett Jack (10/20) and Ryan Kelly (10/19).
