### UPCOMING GAMES



**Tuesday, Nov. 15, 2016 at Miami Heat (7:30 p.m.)**  
**TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

The Hawks travel to Miami in the first-of-four games with the Heat ... The teams will meet again in Atlanta on 12/7 and 2/24, and once more in Miami on 2/1 ... The Heat won the 2015-16 series 3-1, with the Hawks taking the first game, a 98-92 road triumph on 11/3/15 ... The Heat were victorious the next three contests, including the last meeting in Miami on 1/31/16 (105-87) ... The Heat lead the all-time series 60-47 and are 38-16 at home.



**Wednesday, Nov. 16, 2016 vs. Milwaukee Bucks (7:30 p.m.)**  
**TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

Atlanta hosts the Bucks in the first-of-four contests between the teams ... The clubs will play again on 12/9 and 3/24 in Milwaukee, and once more at Philips Arena on 1/15 ... The Bucks won the 2015-16 series 2-1, with the Hawks recording a 101-90 home victory in the last game of the series on 3/25/16 ... The Bucks most recent win against the Hawks came on 2/20/16 (117-109 2OT) in Atlanta ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 107-102 and are 68-37 at home.



**Friday, Nov. 18, 2016 at Charlotte Hornets (7:00 p.m.)**  
**TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

Atlanta heads to Charlotte for the first-of-four contests between the clubs ... The teams will matchup again in Atlanta on 12/17 and 4/11, and once more in Charlotte on 3/20 ... Atlanta won the 2015-16 series 3-1, with the Hornets recording its only victory at home on 1/13/16 (107-84) ... The last time the Hawks defeated the Hornets was on 2/28/16 (87-76) at Philips Arena, with the most recent road victory coming on 11/1/15 (94-92) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 60-45, with Charlotte holding a 27-24 advantage at home.



**Sunday, Nov. 20, 2016 at New York Knicks (12:00 p.m.)**  
**TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

Atlanta travels to New York in the first-of-four games against the Knicks ... The teams will play again in Atlanta on 12/28 and 1/29, and once more in The Big Apple on 1/16 ... The clubs split the 2015-16 series, with the Hawks victorious in the first two contests; a 112-101 road decision on 10/29/15 and a 117-98 home triumph on 12/26/15 ... The Knicks won the next two games; at Madison Square Garden on 1/3/16 (111-97) and at Philips Arena on 1/5/16 (107-101) ... New York leads the all-time series 190-173 (91-62 at home).

### COMMUNITY NEWS

\* The True to Atlanta Awards, presented by Kaiser Permanente, returned with the announcement of Leonard Adams as the first recipient for the 2016 – 2017 season. An Army veteran, founder and CEO of the non-profit Quest Community Development Organization, Adams and his staff offer affordable housing, supportive social services and financial management skills to formerly homeless veterans. As part of the recognition, Quest Community Development Organization was awarded a \$1,000 donation as well as 50 tickets to the Hawks vs. Bulls game on 11/9.

\* For the second consecutive year, the Hawks are partnering with BlazeSports and 30 of its Jr. Hawks members for a scrimmage against Hawks staff on 11/19 at 11 a.m. inside the William Walker Recreation Center (2405 Fairburn Rd SW; Atlanta, GA 30331). The event is also open to kids in the staff's network that are wheelchair-bound and have interest in learning more about adaptive sports. Former Hawk Rick Brown will speak at the event and the Hawks are providing uniforms for each team in the youth league.

### NEWS & NOTES

\* On 11/10, the NBA Development League and the Atlanta Hawks Basketball Club announced that the Hawks have acquired the right to own and operate an NBA D-League team that will play in College Park, Ga., beginning with the 2019-20 season. Additionally, the City of College Park has agreed to construct a 3500-seat arena in which the new franchise will serve as the primary tenant. With the purchase, the Hawks become the 16<sup>th</sup> NBA team to own and operate an NBA D-League affiliate, while the NBA D-League grows to 23 teams.

\* Atlanta is on a season-best four game winning streak to improve to 7-2 and first place in the Southeast Division.

\* For the first time this year, Atlanta had eight double-figure scorers in the 115-107 win vs. Chicago (11/9) – Thabo Sefolosha (20), Dwight Howard (18), Paul Millsap (16), Dennis Schröder (13), Kyle Korver (11), Mike Muscala (11), Tim Hardaway Jr. (11) and Malcolm Delaney (10).

\* Dennis Schröder scored a career-high 28 points while tying career-bests in FGM (10) and 3FGM (three) in the victory at Cleveland on 11/8.

\* Dwight Howard (currently 11,261) passed Hall of Famer Dolph Schayes for 27<sup>th</sup> on the all-time NBA/ABA rebounds list vs. Philadelphia on 11/12. Howard finished the evening with his league leading seventh double-double of the season with 10 points and 11 rebounds while adding two assists and one steal in 28 minutes.

\* Kris Humphries (currently 2001) made his 2000<sup>th</sup> career field goal in the win over Philadelphia on 11/12, finishing the night 13 points (5-7 FGs, 1-2 3FGs, 2-2 FTs), nine rebounds, two assists and one block in 18 minutes.

\* Mike Muscala tied a career-high with four assists and added three points, six rebounds and one steal in 19 minutes against Philadelphia on 11/12.

\* Dennis Schröder has scored in double-figures in all nine games this year (the only Hawk to do so), tying the longest single season streak of his career (2/28-3/16/15).

\* The Hawks announced the first in-game concert of the season for 11/22 contest against the New Orleans Pelicans, a halftime performance by Atlanta-based hip hop star Gucci Mane. A special ticket package is available at hawks.com/gucci, which includes a seat for the game and a \$10 food and beverage credit.

\* On 11/3, two members of the Atlanta Hawks Basketball Club were honored by the Atlanta Business Chronicle when guard Kyle Korver and Chief Marketing Officer Melissa Proctor were named to the publication's 2016 "40 Under 40" list.

\* Atlanta Hawks Digital Content Manager Jaryd Wilson was recently named to the inaugural "It List" by Cynopsis at the outlet's fourth annual Digital Model D Awards in New York City. Wilson was among over 40 members selected to the list.
