UPCOMING GAMES



Monday, Nov. 28, 2016 at Golden State Warriors (10:30 p.m.)
TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks visit Golden State for the first-of-two games with the Warriors ... The teams will meet once more at Philips Arena on 3/6 ... The Warriors swept last season's series 2-0 and have taken three straight overall against Atlanta ... Golden State has won four consecutive contests at Oracle Arena vs. Atlanta ... The Hawks' last win against the Warriors was a 102-92 home decision on 2/6/15, while the last road victory came on 2/25/11 (95-79) ... The all-time series is split 142-142, with the Warriors holding a 78-44 advantage at home.



Wednesday, Nov. 30, 2016 at Phoenix Suns (9:00 p.m.)

The Hawks complete their five-game road trip with a visit to Phoenix to take on the Suns in the first-of-two contests between the teams ... The clubs will matchup once more in Atlanta on 3/28 ... The teams split the 2015-16 series 1-1, with each club holding home court and the Hawks winning the final contest 103-90 at Philips Arena on 4/5/16 ... The last time the Hawks won a road game in the series came on 3/13/15 (96-87) ... Phoenix leads the all-time series 70-52 (43-17 at home).



Friday, Dec. 2, 2016 vs. Detroit Pistons (8:00 p.m.)
TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta hosts Detroit in the first-of-three meetings between the clubs ... The teams will meet again at Philips Arena on 12/30 and in Detroit on 1/18 ... The Hawks took the 2015-16 series 3-1 after winning the final three contests, including the last matchup at Philips Arena on 12/23/15 (107-100) ... Detroit's most recent win in the series came in Atlanta on 10/27/15 (106-94) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 176-164 (77-79 at home).



Sat, Dec. 3, 2016 at Toronto Raptors (7:30 p.m.)
TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks travel north of the border in the first-of-three games against Toronto ... The clubs will meet again in Toronto on 12/16 and at Philips Arena on 3/10 ... The Raptors won the 2015-16 series 3-1, with the Hawks victorious 95-87 in the final matchup, at home on 4/7/16 ... Atlanta last defeated the Raptors at the Air Canada Centre on 1/16/15 (110-89) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 43-36, including a 20-19 road mark.

NEWS & NOTES

* Dwight Howard notched the 46th 20-point/20-rebound of his career in the victory at Indiana (11/23) with 23 points and 20 boards. It was his 70th career 20-rebound contest overall. He is the first Hawk since Al Horford on 2/25/13 at Detroit to post a 20/20 game.

* Paul Millsap had 18 points, 11 rebounds, five assists, four steals and three blocks at Indiana (11/23), becoming the first Hawk since Josh Smith on 2/15/12 (at Phoenix) to post at least 18 points, 10 boards, five assists, four steals and three blocks in a game.

* Kent Bazemore (five) and Mike Muscala (two) each tied their career-high in 3FGM on 11/27 at L.A. Lakers. For Muscala, it was the second time in three games he equaled his career-best, having also hit two triples at Indiana on 11/23.

* The Hawks are the only team in the NBA with three players ranked among the Top 20 in spg – Thabo Sefolosha (2.0) is tied for sixth, Kent Bazemore (1.7) is t14th and Paul Millsap (1.6) ranks t20th.

* Malcolm Delaney has made 21 consecutive FTs, with his only miss of the season coming 10/29 at Philadelphia. For the year he is 22-23 from the charity stripe, ranking first among all NBA rookies with a .957 FT%.

* Dwight Howard is third in the league in rpg (12.6) and FG% (.607), while ranking tied for fourth in double-doubles (11), seventh in Eff. FG% (.607) and t10th in bpg (1.7). He is second in the NBA in off. rpg (4.6), having pulled down at least two offensive boards in each game this year, and seventh in def. rpg (8.1).

* The Hawks announced on 11/28 that Atlanta Joint Venture was awarded the contract to serve as construction manager for the upcoming \$192.5 million renovation of Philips Arena. Atlanta Joint Venture is comprised of four of the premier construction companies in the nation with two based locally in Atlanta: Turner Construction Company, AECOM Hunt, SG Contracting and Bryson Constructors. Atlanta-based construction and management firm HJ Russell & Company, in association with Legends Project Development, are serving as the project management team for the project.

December 1, 1972 – The Hawks forced 40 Los Angeles turnovers, a franchise record for most turnovers by an opponent, in a 114-109 overtime road victory against the Lakers.
