UPCOMING GAMES



Tuesday, Dec. 13, 2016 vs. Orlando Magic (7:30 p.m.)

TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks host Orlando in the first-of-four games with the Magic ... The teams will meet again in Orlando on 1/4 and 2/25, and in Atlanta on 2/4 ... The clubs split the 2015-16 series 2-2, with the Hawks winning the first two games; at Orlando on 12/20/15 (103-100) and at Philips Arena on 1/18/16 (98-81), and the Magic victorious in the final two contests; at Orlando on 2/7/16 (96-94) and in Atlanta on 2/8/16 (117-110 OT) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 54-50 (34-17 at home).



Friday, Dec. 16, 2016 at Toronto Raptors (7:30 p.m.)

TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks travel north of the border in the second-of-three games against Toronto ... The clubs will meet once more in Atlanta on 3/10 ... The Raptors took the first contest, a 128-84 home win on 12/3 ... Dwight Howard recorded a double-double (10 points/17rebounds) for the Hawks, while DeMar DeRozan scored 21 points for the home team ... The Raptors have taken three straight home games in the series, with Atlanta's last win in Canada coming on 1/16/15 (110-89) ... The Hawks' most recent victory in the series overall was a 95-87 home triumph on 4/7/16 ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 43-37, including a 20-20 road mark.



Saturday, Dec. 17, 2016 vs. Charlotte Hornets (7:30 p.m.)

TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta hosts Charlotte in the second-of-four contests between the teams ... The clubs will play again in Charlotte on 3/20, and at Philips Arena on 4/11 ... The Hornets took the first matchup, a 100-96 home decision on 11/18, behind 24 points and 10 rebounds from Nicolas Batum ... Paul Millsap recorded 22 points and 13 boards for Atlanta ... Atlanta has won four consecutive home games against the Hornets with Charlotte's most recent victory at Philips Arena occurring on 4/14/14 (95-93) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 60-46 and are 36-18 at home.

* Paul Millsap visited his adopted school of Hollis Innovation Academy this morning (12/12), surprising students who have earned the Hollis Heroes award, presented to those who have exhibited positive behavior and attendance.

* For the second straight year, Mike Muscala partnering with Pay-a-way the Layaway. Later today (12/12), from 3:30-4:30 p.m., Muscala will surprise several customers at Toys "R" Us (2955 Cobb Pkwy. SE, Atlanta, GA 30339) with a special gift – a zero balance on their holiday layaway.

* The Atlanta Hawks staff will purchase and wrap gifts for families the team is adopting from Bert's Big Adventure, an organization that provides special experiences for children with chronic and terminal illnesses.

* Kris Humphries will host families from Hope Atlanta when the Hawks take on the Magic on 12/13. The families will watch pre-game warmups, enjoy dinner in a suite and meet Humphries following the game, where gifts will be presented.

* Hawks players and coaches will host a holiday party for families from Bert's Big Adventure at the Buckhead Club (3344 Peachtree Rd NE., #2600, Atlanta, GA 30326) on 12/14 from 6-8 p.m. Families will enjoy a holiday meal with all of the trimmings and receive presents from their holiday wish list.

NEWS & NOTES

* Atlanta is currently on a two-game winning streak, including a 20-point second half comeback in the 114-110 victory at Milwaukee (12/9). According to ESPN, it was the first time in the Hawks' 68-season history in the NBA to win when trailing by 20-or-more at halftime. It was also the largest deficit overcome for the win in the league this season.

* Dennis Schröder tallied 33 points, four assists, three rebounds, one steal and one block in 40 minutes (12-19 FGs, 4-7 3FGs, 5-5 FTs) at Milwaukee on 12/9, setting or tying career-highs in points, 3FGM and minutes.

* Paul Millsap (currently 11,001) scored his 11,000th career-point at Milwaukee on 12/9, finishing the evening with 23 points, 14 rebounds, six assists, three blocks and one steal, becoming the only player in the league to record at least that stat line in a game this season.

* Mike Muscala posted 11 points (4-6 FGs, 3-3 3FGs), four assists and three rebounds at Milwaukee on 12/9, setting a new career-high with three 3FGM, while tying his career-best of four assists.

* Tim Hardaway Jr. recorded Atlanta's first four-point play of the year, turning the trick at Milwaukee on 12/9.

* The Hawks assigned DeAndre' Bembry to Salt Lake City of the NBA D-League on 12/10 and recalled him on 12/12. Bembry has started two games with the Stars, and averaged 27.0 points, 6.0 rebounds, 5.0 assists and 2.0 steals in 35.7 minutes (.649 FG%).

* The Hawks assigned Mike Scott to Delaware of the NBA Development League on 12/6 and recalled him on 12/9. Scott appeared in two games for the 87ers, averaging 8.5 points, 3.0 rebounds and 1.0 assists in 20.7 minutes.

* On 12/2, it was announced that Hawks' play-by-play radio announcer Steve Holman and former Hawks Assistant Coach Bob Reinhart would be inducted into the Atlanta Sports Hall of Fame. The 13th annual awards and induction ceremony will take place on 2/17/17 at the Buckhead Theatre (3110 Roswell Rd. NE, Atlanta, GA 30305). Tickets are available at atlantasportshalloffame.org.

* On 12/5, it was announced that the Atlanta Hawks, Uber, and Gentleman Jack, have joined together to create a fan pick-up area for games and other events at Philips Arena. The designated area will serve as a convenient meeting point for Uber riders to easily find their drivers when using the popular ride-sharing app. The Gentleman Jack / Uber Pick-Up Zone will be located at the arena's lower level parking in the Philips Lot across from the area known as "The Gulch."
