UPCOMING GAMES



Monday, Dec. 26, 2016 at Minnesota Timberwolves (8:00 p.m.)
TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks visit Minnesota for the only time this year in the second-of-two contests between the clubs ... The Timberwolves notched a 92-84 win at Philips Arena on 12/21 in the first matchup ... Dennis Schröder scored 21 points to lead Atlanta and Paul Millsap recorded a double-double (18 points/10 rebounds), while Andrew Wiggins had 19 points and Karl-Anthony Towns a double-double (17 points/18 boards) for Minnesota ... The Timberwolves currently own a three-game winning streak in the series, including the last meeting in Minnesota, a 99-95 decision on 11/25/15 ... The last Hawks win against Minnesota was a 117-105 road triumph on 2/9/15 ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 32-20 (12-13 on the road).



Wednesday, Dec. 28, 2016 vs. New York Knicks (7:30 p.m.)
TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta welcomes New York in the second-of-four games against the Knicks ... The teams will play again in New York on 1/16, and once more at Philips Arena on 1/29 ... The Knicks took Game 1 on 11/20 (104-94) at Madison Square Garden ... Dwight Howard posted a double-double (18 points/18 rebounds) for Atlanta ... Carmelo Anthony scored 31 points for New York ... The Knicks currently owns a three-game winning streak in the series, including the last meeting at Philips Arena on 1/5/16 (107-101) ... The Hawks last defeated the Knicks on 12/26/15 (117-98) in Atlanta ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 190-174, including a 104-51 home mark.



Friday, Dec. 30, 2016 vs. Detroit Pistons (8:00 p.m.)
TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta hosts Detroit in the second-of-three meetings between the clubs ... The teams will matchup once more in Detroit on 1/18 ... The Pistons lead the 2016-17 series 1-0, with a 121-85 victory on 12/2 at Philips Arena ... Dennis Schröder recorded a double-double (17 points/11 assists) for Atlanta, while Kentavious Caldwell-Pope scored 23 points for Detroit ... The Hawks last defeated the Pistons on 3/26/16 (112-95) in Atlanta ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 176-165 (77-80 at home).



Sunday, Jan. 1, 2016 vs. San Antonio Spurs (6:00 p.m.)
TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD/NBA TV ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks welcome San Antonio in the first-of-two contests with the Spurs ... The clubs will meet once more in San Antonio on 3/13 ... The Spurs swept the 2015-16 series 2-0 and have won 11 consecutive games against the Hawks, with the Atlanta's last victory coming on 3/21/10 (119-114 OT) at Philips Arena ... The Spurs lead the all-time series 51-36, with the Hawks holding a 24-19 advantage at home.

* Kyle Korver is hosting his fourth annual sock drive benefiting the Atlanta Mission, as "Sock It Forward" runs through 12/30. Fans can support the effort by donating new socks at various stations at Philips Arena, Ponce City Market (675 Ponce De Leon Ave. NE, Atlanta, GA 30308) and the Atlanta Mission (2353 Bolton Rd. NW, Atlanta, GA 30318). Additionally, for every pair of socks purchased at a Hawks Shop location, one pair will be donated to Atlanta Mission. New this year, Korver will match the total number of socks donated.

NEWS & NOTES

- * GRAMMY® Award-nominated hip-hop artist 2Chainz will perform at halftime and postgame when the Hawks host Detroit on 12/30. 2Chainz, who last performed at a Hawks game in Mar. 2015, is returning this season with another show, a custom retail piece and a month-long "T.R.U. Tuesdays" philanthropic campaign for fans throughout metro Atlanta. For more information and to buy tickets visit Hawks.com/2chainz.
- * Atlanta is currently on a four-game road winning streak (last loss at Toronto on 12/3), including two straight against Western Conference opponents.
- * Dennis Schröder has scored in double-figures in 15 consecutive games, the longest streak of his career. He is averaging 21.0 ppg on .498 FG%, .373 3FG% and .900 FT% during the stretch.
- * In the victory at Oklahoma City on 12/19, Dennis Schröder (31 points, 10-16 FGs) and Paul Millsap (30 points, 12-18 FGs) became the first two Hawks to score at least 30 points and shoot at least .600 from the field in the same game since Joe Johnson (36 points, 14-18 FGs) and Al Harrington (35 points, 13-19 FGs) pulled it off against New York on 12/16/05. The last two Hawks to score 30-or-more points in the same game were Johnson (34) and Josh Smith (33) at Denver on 3/13/12.
- * Dennis Schröder knocked down a career-high 10-10 FTs and equaled a career-best with 40 minutes played at Oklahoma City on 12/19, finishing the night with 31 points (10-16 FGs, 1-3 3FGs), eight assists and five rebounds.
- * Against Minnesota on 12/21, Kyle Korver and Kent Bazemore finished with four blocks apiece, with Bazemore setting a new career-high and Korver equaling his career-best. Korver's four blocks all came in the second quarter and he is the first Hawk to record at least four blocks in a single period since Elton Brand (four) at Boston on 2/26/14.
- * Mike Muscala tied a career-high with three 3FGM (3-3) vs. Minnesota on 12/21, finishing the game with 16 points, four rebounds and one steal (6-9 FGs, 1-1 FTs).
- * Paul Millsap had his fifth 30-point point scoring effort in a Hawks uniform at Oklahoma City (12/19), as Atlanta improved to 5-0 all-time when Millsap goes for 30-or-more.
- * The Hawks assigned DeAndre' Bembry to Salt Lake City of the NBA Development League on 12/21 and recalled him on 12/23. Bembry has been assigned to Salt Lake City of the D-League on three occasions, averaging 20.3 points, 5.0 rebounds, 5.0 assists and 1.7 steals in 32.7 minutes (.578 FG%, .636 FT%) in three games with the Stars.

December 30, 1978 – John Drew scores 50 points in Atlanta's 113-87 home win over Denver. Drew's effort is tied for the ninth-highest single-game scoring total in club history.
