UPCOMING GAMES



Monday, Dec. 5, 2016 vs. Oklahoma City Thunder (7:30 p.m.)

TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks host Oklahoma City in the first-of-two games with the Thunder ... The teams will close the season series in Oklahoma City on 12/19 ... The clubs split last year's series 1-1, as each team held home court and the Hawks winning the first matchup at Philips Arena on 11/30/15 (106-100) ... The Thunder evened things up with a 107-94 triumph on 12/10/15 ... Atlanta has taken two straight home decisions in the series, with Oklahoma City's last win at Philips Arena coming on 12/10/13 (101-92) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 65-63 (40-25 at home).



Wednesday, Dec. 7, 2016 vs. Miami Heat (7:30 p.m.)

TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta welcomes the Heat in the second-of-four meetings between the clubs ... The teams will matchup again in Miami on 2/1 and at Philips Arena on 2/24 ... The Hawks lead the season series 1-0, after a 93-90 road triumph on 11/15 ... Dennis Schröder scored 18 points and Dwight Howard had a double-double (11 points/11 rebounds) for the Hawks ... Hassan Whiteside posted a double-double (19 points/25 boards) for the Heat ... The Heat have taken two-in-a-row against Atlanta at Philips Arena, with the Hawks' last home win coming on 3/27/15 (99-86) ... Miami leads the all-time series 60-47, with Atlanta holding a 31-22 advantage at home.



Friday, Dec. 9, 2016 at Milwaukee Bucks (8:00 p.m.)

The Hawks travel to Milwaukee in the second-of-four contests between the teams ... The clubs will meet again in Atlanta on 1/15 and in Milwaukee on 3/24 ... The Hawks took the first matchup, a 107-100 home victory on 11/16 ... Paul Millsap had 21 points for Atlanta, while Giannis Antetokounmpo posted a double-double (26 points/15 rebounds) for the Bucks ... The Hawks have taken two straight overall in the series (both at home), while the Bucks have won two straight in Milwaukee ... The Bucks' last win against the Hawks was a 117-109 double-overtime decision at Philips Arena on 2/20/16 ... Atlanta's last win at Milwaukee came on 2/22/15 (97-86) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 107-102 (38-63 on the road).

COMMUNITY NEWS

* Kyle Korver is hosting his fourth annual sock drive benefiting the Atlanta Mission, as "Sock It Forward" runs from 11/22-12/30. NW, Atlanta, GA 30318). Additionally, for every pair of socks purchased at a Hawks Shop location, one pair will be donated to Atlanta Mission.

* On 12/3 the Atlanta Hawks Alumni Association, in conjunction with Dekalb County Parks and Recreation, participated in a youth clinic at Gresham Park and Rec Center. Atlanta Hawks Cheerleaders and former guard Salim Stoudamire were on hand for the "Basketball Fan Fare" which served as the official tip off to the league's basketball season.

* On 12/11 Dwight Howard will host his "3-Point Santa Project" for 50 members of a local Boys & Girls Club. Held throughout Atlantic Station (1380 Atlantic Drive Northwest, Atlanta, GA 30363) each child will receive a "WISH" from Target, a "NEED" provided by Dillard's and a "REALLY GREAT READ" selected by Howard in partnership with the Barbara Bush Houston Literacy Foundation.

NEWS & NOTES

* Dennis Schröder recorded his third double-double of the season with 17 points (7-13 FGs, 1-2 3FGs, 2-3 FTs) and a career-high tying 11 assists, while adding two rebounds in 24:56 of playing time vs. Detroit (12/2), becoming the first Hawk in franchise history to record 17 points and 11 assists in under 25 minutes.

* Dennis Schröder recorded 31 points (13-23 FGs), nine assists, four rebounds and one block in at Phoenix on 11/30, setting career-highs in points and FGM.

* Kent Bazemore (currently 2023) scored his 2000th career point at Phoenix on 11/30, finishing the night with 22 points, five rebounds, three assists, three steals and one block.

* Dwight Howard (currently 3185) passed Terry Cummings for 25th in NBA/ABA history in offensive rebounds at Toronto on 12/3, ending the game with 10 points, 17 rebounds, two blocks and one assist.

* The Hawks assigned DeAndre' Bembry to Salt Lake City of the NBA Development League on 11/30 and recalled him on 12/2. In one game with Salt Lake City, Bembry recorded 35 points (16-22 FGs, 1-4 3FGs, 2-3 FTs), six rebounds, six assists, two steals and one block in 36 minutes at Los Angeles on 12/1.

* Mike Scott made his season debut at Phoenix on 11/30, grabbing one rebound in four minutes of action, after missing the first 18 games of the year with a sore left knee.

* On 11/29 the Atlanta Hawks Basketball Club announced a collaboration with Anheuser-Busch to introduce co-branded Budweiser cans to celebrate the start of the season. Atlanta Beverage Company and Eagle Rock Distributing Company are distributing over 600,000 12-ounce cans in the local market, featuring the Hawks' primary logo alongside Budweiser's iconic logo. Additional Budweiser co-branded items including merchandise, team schedules, billboards, and retail signage will also be in market in support of the partnership.

* The Atlanta Hawks Basketball Club has designated the 12/17 game against the Charlotte Hornets (7:30 p.m. tip off) as "Ryan Cameron Night" in honor of the team's popular Public Address Announcer. The night's in-game recognition of Cameron, a two-time Emmy Award winner, will feature halftime performances by DJ Jelly, Fabo, and Kilo Ali.
