UPCOMING GAMES



Monday, Jan. 16, 2017 at New York Knicks (1:00 p.m.)

TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD/ NBA TV ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta travels to New York in the third-of-four contests between the teams ... The clubs will matchup once more at Philips Arena on 1/29 ... The 2016-17 series is split 1-1, with the Knicks victorious 104-94 at Madison Square Garden on 11/20 and Atlanta a 102-98 overtime winner at Philips Arena on 12/28 ... Dwight Howard is averaging 17.0 ppg, 20.0 rpg, 2.0 bpg and 1.5 apg against the Knicks this season, while Kristaps Porzingis is averaging 21.5 ppg, 9.5 rpg and 1.5 bpg against the Hawks ... New York has taken two straight home games in the series with Atlanta's last win coming on 10/29/15 (112-101) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 191-174 (62-92 road mark).



Wednesday, Jan. 18, 2017 at Detroit Pistons (8:00 p.m.)

TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD/ESPN ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks travel to Detroit in the third-and-final meetings between the clubs ... The 2016-17 series is split 1-1, after the Pistons were victorious 121-85 at Philips Arena on 12/2 and the Hawks a 105-98 home winner on 12/30 ... Dennis Schröder is averaging 17.0 ppg, 9.0 apg, 1.5 rpg and 1.0 spg against the Pistons this year, while Jon Leuer is averaging 19.0 ppg, 7.5 rpg, 1.5 apg and 1.5 spg against the Hawks ... Atlanta has won two consecutive games in The Motor City, with Detroit's last home win coming on 3/31/15 (105-95) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 177-165, and are 85-74 on the road.



Friday, Jan. 20, 2017 vs. Chicago Bulls (8:00 p.m.)

TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta welcomes Chicago for the final time this season in the second-of-four meetings between the teams ... The clubs will matchup again in The Windy City on 1/25 and 4/1 ... The Hawks took the first contest, a 115-107 home victory on 11/9, in which Dwight Howard (18 points/10 rebounds) recorded a double-double for the Hawks and Jimmy Butler tallied 39 points, seven assists, six steals and four rebounds for the Bulls ... Atlanta has won five consecutive games against Chicago overall, including four straight at Philips Arena ... Chicago's last win the series was a 91-85 home decision on 4/15/15, while the last win in Atlanta came on 4/2/14 (105-92) ... The Bulls lead the all-time series 123-109, with Atlanta holding a 65-49 edge at home.



Saturday, Jan. 21, 2017 vs. Philadelphia 76ers (7:00 p.m.)

TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks host the 76ers in the third-of-four contests between the teams ... The clubs will meet once more in Philadelphia on 3/29 ... Atlanta leads the 2016-17 series 2-0, after winning 104-72 in Philadelphia on 10/29 and 117-96 at home on 11/12 ... Atlanta has won five straight overall and six consecutive at home against Philadelphia, with the Sixers most recent victory occurring on 3/7/15 (92-84) at home, and their last win in Atlanta happening on 4/5/13 (101-90) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 170-160 (103-52 home mark).

COMMUNITY NEWS

* On 1/28 and 1/29 the Hawks Basketball Academy will host a two-day training camp for children ages 8-14 at the Salvation Army Kroc Corps Community Center (967 Dewey St. SW, Atlanta, GA 30310) and Philips Arena. Participants will be lead through games, skills competitions, and basketball drills by former Hawks guard Salim Stoudamire and Basketball Development Coaches. Campers will receive a Hawks camp jersey and a ticket to the Hawks vs. Knicks game on 1/29. A contingent of eight Chinese students spending their winter break in America, will also participate in the camp.

* Mike Muscala will hold a vision screening from 9:30-10:30 a.m. at Brown Middle School (765 Peebles St. SW, Atlanta, GA 30310) on 1/30. Muscala will speak to approximately 100 students (some of whom will be receiving free eyeglasses at a later date) and then assist with the screenings for the students.

* In conjunction with NBA Fit, 100 students from Tuskegee Airmen Global Academy will visit Philips Arena on 1/30 and participate in the Hawks Fit activation, rotating through three stations (barre, dance/fitness and a basketball station). Hawks players, coaches and staff will participate along with the students.

NEWS & NOTES

* Atlanta recorded a season-best seven game win streak from 12/28-1/10 and is 13-5 in the last 18 games.

* The Hawks own a 12-9 road record this year, the fourth-best mark away from home in the Eastern Conference.

* Dwight Howard is the active NBA leader with 639 career double-doubles (26 this year), including one triple-double. Howard has averaged a point/rebound double-double in each of his first 12 NBA seasons, one-of-nine players in league history to do so.

* Last week Paul Millsap (currently 6020 rebounds, 269 3FGM), recorded his 6,000th career rebound and passed Josh Smith for 10th on the Hawks all-time list in 3FGM.

* Dennis Schröder (currently 1007 assists) recorded his 1,000th career assist vs. Boston on 1/13.

* Tim Hardaway Jr. tied a career-high with two blocks in the victory at Brooklyn on 1/10 and tied a career-best with three steals against Boston on 1/13, while finishing the game with 23 points, two rebounds, two assists and one block off the bench.

* Last week Dwight Howard (currently 11,627) passed Patrick Ewing for 25th in rebounds in NBA/ABA history.

* At New York on 1/16, Atlanta will be playing a Martin Luther King Jr. Holiday game for the 26th time (22 games at home and four on the road, including today). The Hawks are 16-9 all-time (15-7 at home and 1-2 on the road) on the holiday and have won six consecutive games.

THIS WEEK IN HAWKS HISTORY

January 16, 1972 – Pete Maravich scores 50 points in Atlanta's 124-116 home win over Philadelphia. It is tied for the eighth-highest scoring game in Hawks history. Exactly one year later, Maravich put his name in the record books again by dishing out 18 assists in Atlanta's 130-129 home win over Detroit in overtime. It is tied for the fifth-highest assist total in club history.
