UPCOMING GAMES



Monday, Jan. 23, 2017 vs. Los Angeles Clippers (7:30 p.m.)

TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta welcomes the Clippers in the first-of-two games between the teams ... The clubs will meet once more in Los Angeles on 2/15 ... The Hawks and Clippers split the 2015-16 series 1-1, with Atlanta victorious, 107-97, in the series finale at Staples Center on 3/5/16 ... The last time Atlanta defeated Los Angeles at Philips Arena was on 12/23/14 (107-104) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 76-40 and are 44-14 at home.



Wednesday, Jan. 25, 2017 at Chicago Bulls (8:00 p.m.)

TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks travel to Chicago in the third-of-four contests against the Bulls ... The teams will match up once more in The Windy City on 4/1 ... The Hawks lead the 2016-17 series 2-0, after home victories on 11/9 (115-107) and 1/20 (102-93) ... Paul Millsap is averaging 15.0 ppg, 10.0 rpg, 4.0 apg, 2.0 bpg and 1.0 spg against the Bulls this season, while Jimmy Butler is posting 29.0 ppg, 5.0 apg, 3.5 spg and 2.0 rpg against the Hawks ... Atlanta has won six consecutive games against Chicago overall, including two straight on the road, with the Bulls' most recent victory coming on 4/15/15 (91-85) at the United Center ... Chicago leads the all-time series 123-110 (71-42 at home).



Friday, Jan. 27, 2017 vs. Washington Wizards (8:00 p.m.)

TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta welcomes Washington for the final time this season in the third-of-four meetings between the teams ... The clubs will play once more in the Nation's Capital on 3/22 ... The 2016-17 series is split 1-1, after Atlanta won 114-99 at home on 10/27 and Washington was the 95-92 victor at the Verizon Center on 11/4 ... Paul Millsap is averaging 22.0 ppg, 7.0 rpg, 4.0 apg and 2.0 spg against the Wizards this season, while Bradley Beal is putting up 20.5 ppg, 3.5 apg and 1.0 rpg against the Hawks ... The last time the Wizards defeated the Hawks at Philips Arena was on 3/21/16 (117-102) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 151-141 and is 96-44 at home.



Sunday, Jan. 29, 2017 vs. New York Knicks (3:00 p.m.)

TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks host the Knicks in the fourth-and-final contest between the teams ... Atlanta leads the 2016-17 series 2-1, with the Knicks victorious in the first meeting, 104-94, at Madison Square Garden on 11/20, and Atlanta the winner of the last two contests; 102-98 in overtime at Philips Arena on 12/28 and 108-107 in New York on 1/16 ... Dennis Schröder is averaging 18.7 ppg, 3.7 apg and 1.7 rpg against the Knicks this season, while Carmelo Anthony is recording 23.7 ppg, 6.3 rpg, 2.0 apg and 1.0 spg against the Hawks ... The Knicks' most recent victory in Atlanta was on 1/5/16 (107-101) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 192-174 (105-51 at home).

COMMUNITY NEWS

* On 1/28 and 1/29 the Hawks Basketball Academy will host a two-day training camp for children ages 8-14 at the Salvation Army Kroc Corps Community Center (967 Dewey St. SW, Atlanta, GA 30310) and Philips Arena. Activities include games, skills competitions, and basketball drills led by former Hawks guard Salim Stoudamire and Basketball Development Coaches. Campers will receive a Hawks camp jersey and a ticket to the Hawks vs. Knicks game on 1/29. A contingent of eight Chinese students spending their winter break in America will also take part in the camp.

* In conjunction with NBA Fit, 100 students from Tuskegee Airmen Global Academy will visit Philips Arena on 1/30 and participate in the Hawks Fit activation, rotating through three stations (barre, dance/fitness and a basketball station). Hawks players, coaches and staff will take part along with the students.

* The Hawks will host the third annual Atlanta Hawks Fast Break 5K at Philips Arena at 8 a.m. on 2/4. Pre-race online registration is currently open and includes a free race day parking pass, ticket to a Hawks game, a \$10 food voucher, and a commemorative long sleeve shirt. NEWS & NOTES

* The Hawks are 16-6 in their last 22 games (9-2 in January), including wins in 11-of-the-last-13 contests (two straight). Atlanta has also won five-of-the-last-six road games and has taken three in a row at Philips Arena.

* Atlanta is averaging 10.5 offensive rpg on the year, having hauled down at least 10 offensive boards 26 times, including streaks of seven, five and three consecutive games. Last season the Hawks had 26 games total with double-digit offensive rebounds (longest streak was three games).

* Paul Millsap is one-of-four players in the NBA (Kevin Durant, Giannis Antetokounmpo and DeMarcus Cousins) this season averaging at least 17.0 ppg, 8.0 rpg, 3.0 apg, 1.0 spg and 1.0 bpg. He leads Atlanta in ppg (17.9), while ranking second in rpg (8.1), apg (3.8), spg (1.5) and bpg (1.0).

* Dennis Schröder recorded 28 points (13-16 FGs, 1-2 3FGs, 1-1 FTs), three rebounds and three assists in 34 minutes in the victory at New York on 1/16; tying a career-high in FGM and becoming the first Hawk to make 13-or-more field goals on at least .800 FG% since Josh Smith (14-16 FGs) vs. New Jersey on 12/7/10.

* Tim Hardaway Jr. dished out a career-best six assists in the victory against Philadelphia on 1/21 and tied a career-high with three steals in the win vs. Chicago on 1/20.

* On 1/18, the Hawks signed free agent Gary Neal to a 10-day contract. In a separate transaction, the club acquired the draft rights to Cenk Akyol and a Traded Player Exception as part of a trade with Denver for Mo Williams.

* Atlanta Hawks EVP, Brand and Innovation & Chief Creative Officer Peter Sorckoff was recognized as a member of the Technology Association of Georgia's Game Changers – Sports Technology list on 1/18. Members of the 12-person list were chosen due to an "excellent record of success, game-changing achievements in their discipline/industry and dedication to Georgia's tech community."

* On 1/18, the Georgia Association of Broadcasters (GAB) announced Steve Holman was a member of the 2017 Hall of Fame class. The 2017 Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony will be held at UGA's Richard B. Russell Special Collections Library (300 S Hull St., Athens, GA 30602) at 11:00 a.m. on 2/24.

* Hometown hip-hop artist Lil Yachty will perform at halftime when the Hawks host the Washington Wizards on 1/27. Tickets for the contest are available at Hawks.com/yachty and they include an option with a \$10 food and beverage credit.
