UPCOMING GAMES



Wednesday, Feb. 1, 2017 at Miami Heat (7:30 p.m.)
TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta travels to Miami for the final time this year in the third-of-four games between the teams ... The clubs will meet once more at Philips Arena on 2/24 ... The Hawks lead the 2016-17 series 2-0, after a 93-90 road win on 11/15 and 103-95 home decision on 12/7 ... Paul Millsap is averaging 18.0 ppg, 7.5 rpg, 3.0 apg, 3.0 spg and 1.5 bpg against the Heat this season, while Hassan Whiteside is posting 13.6 ppg, 18.5 rpg, 1.0 apg, 1.0 spg and 1.0 bpg against the Hawks ... The Heat's last win in the series came on 2/19/16 (115-111) at Philips Arena, while the most recent home victory was on 1/31/16 (105-87) ... Miami leads the all-time series 60-49 (38-17 at home).



Thursday, Feb. 2, 2017 at Houston Rockets (8:00 p.m.)
TV: TNT ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks visit Houston for the only time this season in the second-of-two contests against the Rockets ... Atlanta took the first meeting 112-97 at Philips Arena on 11/5, in which Dwight Howard (20 points/15 rebounds) and Paul Millsap (23 points/11 boards) each recorded a double-double, while James Harden had 30 points and 11 assists for Houston ... Atlanta has won six consecutive games against the Rockets, including two straight on the road ... Houston's last win in the series was a 113-84 home triumph on 11/27/13 ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 75-74, with the Rockets holding a 52-22 advantage at home.



Saturday, Feb. 4, 2017 vs. Orlando Magic (7:00 p.m.)
TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta welcomes Orlando for the final time this season in the third-of-four meetings between the teams ... The clubs will play once more in Orlando on 2/25 ... The 2016-17 series is split 1-1, with the Magic winning 131-120 at Philips Arena on 12/13 and the Hawks victorious 111-92 in Orlando on 1/4 ... Dennis Schröder is averaging 18.5 ppg, 10.0 apg, 3.5 rpg and 1.5 spg against the Magic this season ... Elfrid Payton is posting 20.5 ppg, 10.0 apg, 3.5 rpg and 2.5 spg against the Hawks this year ... Orlando has taken the last two matchups at Philips Arena, with Atlanta's last home win coming on 1/18/16 (98-81) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 55-51 and is 34-18 at home.



Monday, Feb. 6, 2017 vs. Utah Jazz (7:30 p.m.)
TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks host the Jazz in the second-and-final contest between the clubs ... Utah recorded a 95-68 home victory in the first matchup on 11/25, where Dennis Schröder scored 16 points for the Hawks and Gordon Hayward tallied 24 points for the Jazz ... Utah took the last meeting at Philips Arena on 11/15/15 (97-96) ... The Jazz lead the all-time series 50-48, with the Hawks holding a 30-17 edge at home.

*The Atlanta Hawks Basketball Club has been named a finalist in three categories in the annual Cynopsis Social Good Awards. The Hawks are finalists in the: 1.) Diversity Campaign or Initiative, for the Unity Weekend initiative; 2.) Philanthropic/Human Rights Campaign, for the Hawks Court Renovation program; 3.) Best Spot (over 30 seconds), for the True to Atlanta television commercial. The Awards Breakfast will take place in New York City on 3/2.

* On 2/4, the Hawks Basketball Academy will host the second girls Game Day Clinic on the Philips Arena practice court beginning at 1 p.m. Girls ages 6-14 will be invited to participate in basketball drills and hear from a member of the WNBA's Atlanta Dream. Each participant will receive a Jr. Hawks jersey and a ticket to the Hawks home game against Orlando later that night. The event coincides with the 2/1 celebration of the National Girls and Women in Sports Day.

* The Hawks will host the third annual Atlanta Hawks Fast Break 5K at Philips Arena at 8 a.m. on 2/4. Pre-race online registration is currently open and includes a free race day parking pass, ticket to a Hawks game, a \$10 food voucher, and a commemorative long sleeve shirt. NEWS & NOTES

* Paul Millsap was selected by the Eastern Conference coaches to his fourth consecutive All-Star team, and he will compete in the 2017 NBA All-Star Game on 2/19 in his home state at Smoothie King Center in New Orleans, LA. Millsap joins Dominique Wilkins, Bob Pettit, Lou Hudson, Joe Johnson, Dikembe Mutombo and Cliff Hagan as the only players in franchise history to earn All-Star honors in four straight seasons.

* The Hawks are 18-8 in the last 26 games (finished 11-4 in January), including wins in 13-of-the-last-17 contests.

* The four-overtime victory against New York on 1/29 was the third four-overtime game in Hawks' franchise history (3-0 record) and 11th in NBA history. The previous games were a 139-133 win vs. Utah on 3/25/12 and a 127-122 victory at Seattle on 2/19/82.

* The Hawks lead the 2016-17 season series against the Bulls 3-0 and have tied their longest win streak against Chicago with seven consecutive victories (1/9/16-1/25/17). The two previous seven-game streaks occurred from 1/8/83-2/25/84 and 3/14/67-2/10/68.

* Atlanta's five starters (Thabo Sefolosha, Paul Millsap, Dwight Howard, Kent Bazemore and Dennis Schröder), along with Tim Hardaway Jr. off the bench all scored at least 16 points in the victory at Chicago on 1/25. It was the third time in franchise history, and the first in over 47 years, that team had six players score more than 15 points in the same game (previously on 3/10/65 against Cincinnati and 12/31/69 against Baltimore).

* Paul Millsap recorded his 13th double-double of the season with 37 points and 19 rebounds, while tallying seven assists, one steal and one block against New York on 1/29. The last NBA player to record at least those totals in points, rebounds, assists, steals and blocks was Charles Barkley for Phoenix vs. the Clippers on 11/7/92 (37 pts/21 rebs/8 assts/1 stl/1 blk).

* Against New York on 1/29, Paul Millsap (currently 282 3FGM) tied Jamal Crawford for ninth in club history in three-pointers made.

* Dennis Schröder (currently 1010 FGM) made his 1000th career field goal versus Washington on 1/27.

* Tim Hardaway Jr. recorded career-highs in assists (eight) and minutes (58) and tied a career-best in FTM (nine); Paul Millsap (60), Dennis Schröder (55) and Kent Bazemore (50) all set career-highs in minutes vs. New York on 1/29.

* The Hawks signed free agent Lamar Patterson to a 10-day contract on 1/29.

THIS WEEK IN HAWKS HISTORY

February 5, 1972 – Pete Maravich scores 50 points in Atlanta's 120-117 home win over Cleveland. It is tied for the ninth-highest single game scoring effort in franchise history. Maravich's 20 made field goals (20-27) are tied for sixth on the club's all-time list.
