UPCOMING GAMES



Tuesday, Jan. 10, 2017 at Brooklyn Nets (7:30 p.m.)
TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks travel to Brooklyn in the first-of-four meetings between the teams ... The clubs will matchup again in Atlanta on 3/8 and 3/26, and once more in Brooklyn on 4/2 ... The Hawks won the 2015-16 series 2-1, and were victorious 114-86 in the series finale at Philips Arena on 1/16/16 ... The last time the Hawks defeated the Nets in Brooklyn was on 4/8/15 (114-111) and the Nets' most recent victory against Atlanta was on 11/17/15 (90-88) at the Barclays Center ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 97-70 (36-48 road mark).



Friday, Jan. 13, 2017 vs. Boston Celtics (8:00 p.m.)
TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD/ESPN ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta welcomes Boston in the first-of-three games against the Celtics ... The teams will meet again in Atlanta on 2/27 and 4/6 ... The Hawks won the 2015-16 series 3-1, with the Celtics winning the first meeting 106-93 in Boston on 11/13/15 and the Hawks victorious in the next three contests, including a 118-107 series finale victory at Philips Arena on 4/9/16 ... In the first round of the 2016 Playoffs, Atlanta defeated Boston in six games (4-2) ... The Hawks have won four straight regular season home games against the Celtics, with Boston's most recent victory at Philips Arena occurring on 11/23/13 (106-93) ... The Celtics lead the all-time series 229-140, with the Hawks holding an 89-82 advantage at home.



Sunday, Jan. 15, 2017 vs. Milwaukee Bucks (3:00 p.m.)
TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks welcome Milwaukee for the final time this season in the third-of-four meetings between the clubs ... The teams will matchup once more in Milwaukee on 3/24 ... The Hawks lead the 2016-17 series 2-0, after posting a 107-100 home win on 11/16 and 114-110 road decision on 12/9 ... Dennis Schröder is averaging 22.5 ppg, 6.0 apg, 3.0 rpg and 1.0 spg against the Bucks this season ... Jabari Parker is averaging 25.0 ppg, 6.0 rpg, 3.5 apg and 3.0 spg against the Hawks this year ... The Bucks' most recent victory against Atlanta was a 117-109 double overtime triumph at Philips Arena on 2/20/16 ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 109-102, and are 69-37 at home.



Monday, Jan. 16, 2017 at New York Knicks (1:00 p.m.)

Atlanta travels to New York in the third-of-four contests between the teams ... The clubs will play once more in Atlanta on 1/29 ... The 2016-17 series is split 1-1, with the Knicks victorious 104-94 at Madison Square Garden on 11/20 and Atlanta a 102-98 overtime winner at Philips Arena on 12/28 ... Dwight Howard is averaging 17.0 ppg, 20.0 rpg, 2.0 bpg and 1.5 apg against the Knicks this season ... Kristaps Porzingis is averaging 21.5 ppg, 9.5 rpg and 1.5 bpg against the Hawks this year ... Atlanta last defeated the Knicks in New York on 10/29/15 (112-101) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 191-174 (62-92 road mark).

COMMUNITY NEWS

* On 1/5 the Hawks Basketball Academy, in partnership with the Positive Coaching Alliance hosted a coaching workshop, *Coaching for Winning and Life Lessons*, at The Villages at Carver Family YMCA. The Positive Coaching Alliance strives to create a positive, character-building youth sports culture by traveling nationwide to deliver live group workshops, online courses, and books to coaches of all levels. Approximately 25 coaches from all Metro-Atlanta YMCAs went through the two-hour interactive workshop.

* The Atlanta Hawks MLK Classic will run from 1/14-1/15. The MLK Classic, held at Adamsville Recreation Center (3201 M.L.K. Jr Dr SW, Atlanta, GA 30311) from 11:45 a.m. – 5:30 p.m. will have participation from Cobb County, City of Atlanta, and Fulton County; in a basketball tournament where both girls and boys teams (ages 12-13) will play. Hawks players will be on hand as celebrity guest coaches, with the tournament's championship game played at Philips Arena on 1/15. Each player will receive a customized MLK Classic jersey and a Hawks game ticket to the 1/15 home contest against Milwaukee. On 1/15, players that participated in the MLK Classic will attend a luncheon which will be hosted at the Omni Atrium (100 CNN Center NW, Atlanta, GA 30303) at 12 p.m. Keynote speaker Inky Johnson, former Tennessee football player and Atlanta native, will address the young athletes.

* January is National Mentoring Month and the Atlanta Hawks are supporting it by facilitating community conversations, providing tickets for mentors/mentees and in-arena recruitment messages. On 1/15 members of the Atlanta Hawks staff will participate in a career development panel speaking to 50 young men of color from McClarin Success Academy, an alternative high school in College Park, GA. Following the panel, students will be given tickets to enjoy the Hawks home game against the Bucks. Prior to their arena visit, on 1/12, Mike Scott, Malcolm Delaney and DeAndre' Bembry, will visit McClarin (3605 E Main St, College Park, GA 30337) at 2:30 p.m. for conversations with 100 students.

NEWS & NOTES

* Atlanta is currently on a six-game win streak (tying a season-long; 11/5-11/16) and is 11-4 over its last 15 games. During the win streak, the Hawks are averaging 104.7 ppg (628), 23.7 apg (142) and 47.8 rpg (287) on .436 FG% (230-527) and .407 3FG% (59-145); scoring at least 100 points in four games and holding the opponent below the century mark five times (one game below 90 points).

* Dwight Howard recorded his 23rd double-double of the season with 12 points and 11 rebounds, adding one assist and one block in 29:51 on 1/5 at New Orleans. Howard leads the NBA with 13 double-doubles in 30 minutes-or-less of action and ranks tied for seventh in total double-doubles with 24 this season.

* The Hawks acquired a future first-round draft pick along with Mike Dunleavy and Mo Williams from the Cleveland Cavaliers in exchange for Kyle Korver on 1/7.

* The Hawks recalled Taurean Prince and Mike Scott from Long Island of the NBA Development League on 1/6. Prince has appeared in in four games for the Nets, averaging 21.8 ppg, 8.5 rpg, 2.0 apg, 1.5 spg and 1.0 bpg in 29.8 mpg (.531 FG%, .313 3FG%, .737 FT%). Scott, who has been assigned to the D-League on three occasions this season, has played in six games for the 87ers and Nets, averaging 13.8 points, 4.3 rebounds, 1.7 assists and 1.2 blocks in 23.6 minutes (.414 FG%, .333 3FG%, .333 FT%).

* The Hawks requested waivers on Ryan Kelly on 1/6.

* The 3/5 home game against the Indiana Pacers has changed from a 3 p.m. start to a 1 p.m. tip-off.

THIS WEEK IN HAWKS HISTORY

January 12, 1987 – Dominique Wilkins scores 53 points (19 FGs, 14 FTs) in Atlanta's 125-115 home win over the Los Angeles Clippers. Wilkins' total ranks as the sixth-highest single game scoring effort in franchise history.
