UPCOMING GAMES



Monday, Feb. 6, 2017 vs. Utah Jazz (7:30 p.m.)
TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks host the Jazz in the second-and-final contest between the clubs ... Utah took the first meeting, a 95-68 home victory on 11/25, as Dennis Schröder scored 16 points for the Hawks and Gordon Haywood tallied 24 points for the Jazz ... Atlanta last defeated the Jazz on 3/8/16 (91-84) in Utah, while the most recent home win came on 11/12/14 (100-97) ... Utah took the last matchup at Philips Arena, 97-96, on 11/15/15 ... The Jazz lead the all-time series 50-48, with the Hawks holding a 30-17 edge in home games.



Wednesday, Feb. 8, 2017 vs. Denver Nuggets (7:30 p.m.)
TV: FOX Sports Southeast ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta welcomes Denver for the only time this season in the second-of-two contests between the clubs ... The Hawks took the first meeting, a 109-108 road decision on 12/23, behind Dennis Schröder's 27 points, six rebounds, five assists and one steal ... Danilo Gallinari posted a double-double (21 points/11 rebounds) for the Nuggets ... The Hawks have won three consecutive games against Denver overall and four straight at Philips Arena ... The last time the Nuggets defeated the Hawks was a 115-102 home triumph on 3/11/15, with the most recent victory at Philips Arena coming on 3/16/11 (102-87) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 46-38 and is 33-7 at home.



Friday, Feb. 10, 2017 at Sacramento Kings (10:30 p.m.)
TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks travel to Sacramento for the only time this year in the second-of-two-games against the Kings ... Atlanta leads the 2016-17 series 1-0, after a 106-95 win at Philips Arena on 10/31 ... In the victory, Dwight Howard recorded a double-double (18 points/11 rebounds) for Atlanta and DeMarcus Cousins posted a double-double (14 points/12 boards) for Sacramento ... The Kings took the last meeting in Sacramento (91-88) on 1/21/16 ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 158-153, with the Kings holding a 72-45 advantage at home.



Monday, Feb. 13, 2017 at Portland Trail Blazers (10:30 p.m.)
TV: TNT ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta visits Portland in the first-of-two-meetings between the clubs ... The teams will matchup once more at Philips Arena on 3/18 ... The Hawks swept the 2015-16 series 2-0, with a 106-97 victory in Atlanta on 12/21/15 and a 104-98 win in Portland on 1/20/16 ... Atlanta has won four consecutive games against the Trail Blazers overall, including two straight in Portland ... The last time the Trail Blazers defeated the Hawks was on 3/27/14 (100-85) in Atlanta, and their most recent home victory occurred on 3/5/14 (102-78) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 56-53 (20-34 road record).

COMMUNITY NEWS

* On 1/30, the Hawks recognized the February True to Atlanta Honoree Dana Marie Lupton. The True to Atlanta awards, presented by Kaiser Permanente, recognize leaders who are using volunteerism to empower their communities. Lupton's non-profit 'Moving In The Spirit' uses the art of dance to teach youth goal setting and expressing anger without violence. Lupton was surprised during her weekly dance rehearsal by Harry the Hawk and the Hawks Cheerleaders, and presented with a personalized jersey and tickets to the 2/6 contest against the Utah Jazz.

* Tim Hardaway Jr. and Mike Scott will visit Children's Healthcare of Atlanta (Hughes Spalding campus – 35 Jesse Hill Jr. Dr. SE, Atlanta, GA 30303) on 2/7 from 2:30 -3:30 p.m. The players will be joined by Harry the Hawk to visit the emergency department, subspecialty clinic and inpatient floor.

NEWS & NOTES

* The Hawks are 20-9 in the last 29 games, including wins in three-of-the-last-four, to move to a season-best nine games over .500 (30-21).

* The Hawks came back from 20 points down with less than nine minutes left in the fourth quarter to defeat Houston on 2/2. It was the first time in the past 20 years (since the NBA started keeping track of play-by-play) that Atlanta has trailed by at least 20 points in the fourth quarter and won the game. The Hawks have recorded eight victories this season in which they have trailed by double-digits at one point in a game, including two contests with 20-point deficits.

* The Hawks notched their second wire-to-wire victory of the season in the 113-86 triumph vs. Orlando on 2/4.

* Dwight Howard recorded his second 20-point/20-rebound game of the season with 24 points and 23 boards in the victory over the Rockets on 2/2. It was Howard's first game at Houston after playing the past three seasons for the Rockets, and over the last 30 seasons, only three other players had at least 20 points and 20 rebounds in their first road game against a former team: Moses Malone, playing for Atlanta at Washington on 1/16/89; Charles Barkley, for Houston at Phoenix on 11/2/96; and Drew Gooden, for the Clippers at Dallas on 3/23/10. Howard is also the first Hawk to record at least two 20-point/20-rebound games in the same season since Dikembe Mutombo in 1999-00.

* At Houston on 2/2, Paul Millsap (currently 284 3FGM) passed Jamal Crawford for ninth in club history in three-pointers made.

* Tim Hardaway Jr. scored a career-high 33 points (career-best 12-18 FGs, 4-9 3FGs, 5-7 FTs) at Houston on 2/2, including scoring 23 points in the fourth quarter. The last Hawk to score at least 23 points in any quarter was Salim Stoudamire (24 points) in the fourth against New Orleans/Oklahoma City in Oklahoma City on 11/18/05, and the last Hawk to record at least 20 points in the final period was Joe Johnson (21) at New Jersey 11/14/08.

* The Hawks assigned Taurean Prince to Long Island of the NBA Development League on 2/3 and recalled him on 2/4. Prince is averaging 20.6 ppg, 7.6 rpg, 2.2 apg and 1.6 spg in 28.3 mpg (.500 FG%, .381 3FG%, .714 FT%) in five games with the Nets this season.

THIS WEEK IN HAWKS HISTORY

February 11, 1970 – The Hawks tie the franchise record for points in a game in a 155-131 road win over San Diego. The record was originally set by the St. Louis Hawks on Jan. 24, 1960 against the Knicks.
